We ask that golfers and attendees please review the event information and other details provided below prior to the tournament.

ARRIVAL AT BLACK ROCK COUNTRY CLUB	Please use 155 Ward Street, Hingham, MA for your GPS. If entering "Black Rock Country Club", you may find yourself at an alternate, card-access only gate and will be redirected to the Ward Street gated entrance.
REGISTRATION	Registration begins at 8:00 am. Upon arrival, you will be directed to pull up to the bag drop. When finished, you may park your car and proceed to check-in located in the clubhouse. Celebrity Guests please check-in at the at the Bag Drop with Kim Zayotti with Blue Sky Sports & Entertainment first before proceeding into the clubhouse for general check-in.
GOLF FORMAT	Golfers will play a "scramble" format – foursomes will tee off, then choose the best of the group's shots for the next shot. All golfers then play the 2nd shot from that location and again choose the best shot. This process is continued until the ball is holed. The tournament is at capacity, and we ask all players to be mindful of the pace of play.
GOLF CARTS	Golf carts will be lined up outside the pro shop, near to the flagpole. Club staff will assist guests in finding their carts.
DRESS CODE	Pants/slacks or Bermuda-style shorts, no more than 3″ above the knee. Cargo shorts and jeans/ denim are prohibited. Only spike-less shoes are permitted on the golf course.
	Men- Collared shirts or mock turtlenecks tucked into slacks or shorts. Hats should be worn with bill forward and are to be removed in the clubhouse.
	Women- Shirts with sleeves and collars, round neck shirt with sleeves, and sleeveless shirts with collars are appropriate.
COVID PROTOCALS	There are no restrictions at the club this year. Masks are NOT required. We respect individual decisions to wear a mask and ask that all guests respect one another on their choices to mask or not to mask. Should a guest feel ill or have a confirmed/suspected exposure to COVID-19, we ask that you not attend.
COCKTAIL RECEPTION AND DINNER PROGRAM	Upon finishing play, the cocktail reception will be held upstairs in the clubhouse grill room and adjacent deck. Following the helicopter ball drop (approx. 4:15 pm) we will ask all guests to join Jen and Joe in the main dining room for a light dinner (stations) and a short program. Seating will be available for everyone.
