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## The Joe Andruzzi Foundation Raises Over \$700,000 at 16th Annual Gala

Event featured celebrity guests, launch of new app, and 2023 Game Changer recipients

North Attleboro, MA - (October 27, 2023) – The <u>Joe Andruzzi Foundation (JAF)</u>, providing help, hope, and a reason to smile for New England cancer patients and their families through financial support when it is needed most, hosted its 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Joe Andruzzi Foundation Gala on Thursday, October 26<sup>th</sup> and raised over \$700,000 to help New England-based cancer patients and their families. The event was held in Boston for the first time at the Fairmont Copley Plaza.

This year's gala theme was "Believe," and highlighted the inspiration, collective support, and pure magic that has allowed the Foundation to remove financial barriers for New England cancer patients over the past 16 years. Since its start, the Foundation has granted more than \$10 million to more than 40,000 cancer patients across New England to help ease the pressure of household expenses, food, transportation, extraordinary needs, and wellness resources while undergoing treatment.

"We are so thankful to our wonderful donors who allow us to continue helping those who are facing life-altering diagnoses and treatment," said Joe Andruzzi, Co-Founder and Chief Engagement Officer, Joe Andruzzi Foundation (JAF). "After my personal battle with cancer, I know all too well the financial burden that this disease can create and we never want a patient or their family to choose between paying for medication or paying their rent."

The Foundation unveiled its new Universal Community Oncology Resource Network (UniCORN) for New England cancer patients, families, and healthcare professionals. UniCORN offers patients convenient access to tools and information that are vital on the heels of a cancer diagnosis. It serves as a resource directory, a financial management tool, and a new application system for patients and oncology team members to apply for multiple layers of assistance through one single application.

"UniCORN will transform how cancer patients access support when they need it most," said Jen Andruzzi, CEO and President, Joe Andruzzi Foundation. "The resource directory is now active and the financial tool and common application are in development and will follow soon."

Guests wore festive cocktail attire and enjoyed an evening filled with food, drinks, celebrities, auction items and more, to celebrate and support those impacted by cancer and receiving assistance through the Foundation's variety of grants including household expenses, food, transportation, extraordinary needs, and wellness resources.

In 2022, more than \$1.25 million was distributed in direct assistance to help 4,580 individuals with financial assistance to pay for housing, transportation, utilities, food, insurance, and other household expenses. Since 2008, the Joe Andruzzi Foundation has been able to grant over \$10 million in support to thousands of cancer patients and their families across New England.
