## The Joe Andruzzi Foundation Provides New Washer and Dryer to Cancer Patient

Donation made to a CT patient through Foundation's Extraordinary Needs Program

North Attleboro, MA - (April 26, 2023) – The Joe Andruzzi Foundation (JAF), providing help, hope, and a reason to smile for New England cancer patients and their families through financial support when it's needed most, donated and delivered a new washing machine and dryer to John Parker, a cancer patient in Bristol, Connecticut, on Friday, April 21<sup>st</sup>.

Three-time Super Bowl champion, former New England Patriot and **JAF Chief Engagement Officer Joe Andruzzi**, was on hand for the delivery.

The Joe Andruzzi Foundation helps New Englanders battling cancer through a variety of grants including Household Assistance, Extraordinary Needs, Food Security Assistance, Transportation Assistance, (Up)Beat Opportunities and additional resources. In 2022, more than \$1 million was distributed in direct assistance to help 3,762 individuals with financial assistance to pay for housing, transportation, utilities, food, insurance, and other household expenses.
