The Joe Andruzzi Foundation and Local Families Kick-off 15th Anniversary Road Trip in Massachusetts at WooSox Game

12 JAF patient recipients and families join Joe Andruzzi for WooSox Game

North Attleboro, MA - (May 25, 2023) – The <u>Joe Andruzzi Foundation (JAF)</u>, providing help, hope, and a reason to smile for New England cancer patients and their families through financial support when it's needed most, hosted 12 of its patients and their families at the Worcester Red Sox baseball game at Polar Park Stadium in Worcester, Massachusetts on Sunday, May 21st, kicking off the Massachusetts leg of the Foundation's 15th anniversary Road Trip. The Road Trip began in March in Rhode Island.

Three-time Super Bowl champion, former New England Patriot and **JAF Chief Engagement Officer Joe Andruzzi** was on hand at the (Up)Beat event, which allows patients and their families to spend time away from treatment and enjoy special occasions, experiences, and outings.

The Joe Andruzzi Foundation helps New Englanders battling cancer through a variety of grants including Household Assistance, Extraordinary Needs, Food Security Assistance, Transportation Assistance, (Up)Beat Opportunities and additional resources. In 2022, more than \$1 million was distributed in direct assistance to help 3,762 individuals with financial assistance to pay for housing, transportation, utilities, food, insurance, and other household expenses.
